2011 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Watchung Hills Youth Benevolent Association (“WHYBA”) is committed to helping local high school seniors pursue their goal of obtaining a college education. WHYBA is offering up to \$7,500 in scholarships to qualified graduating high school students who plan to enroll in an accredited college or university program during the 2011-2012 school year. The applicant must be a United States citizen or permanent resident with a minimum 3.0 (B) Grade Point Average.

A minimum of three winners will be chosen based on academic achievement, career goals, character, leadership, community involvement and social awareness. To apply the applicant **must** provide the following items:

1. 250 to 350 word essay that describes the applicant’s aspirations and goals after completing college. The essay must include the applicant’s full name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and high school. The essay must be typewritten, double-spaced with one-inch margins in 12 font.
2. A **one page** resume containing the student’s GPA as well as his or her academic, athletic and extracurricular activities and achievements. The document must be in resume form, typewritten, with one-inch margins in 12 font.
